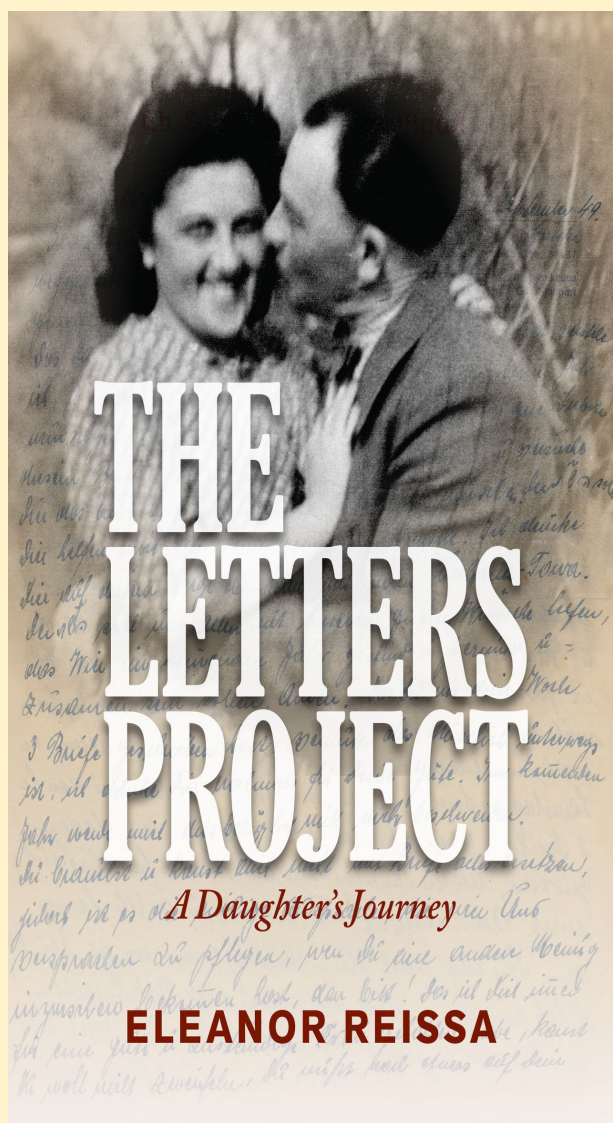


CBI'S Book Review
